Reading Homework

We have been super impressed by the children's progress in phonics and reading. Many thanks for supporting your child at home with the sound sheets sent last term. Please remember all yellow plastic reading wallets are collected on <u>Mondays</u>.

The children will take part in 3 guided reading sessions at school before bringing their new reading books home on <u>Wednesdays</u>.
