What have we been up to this week?

- In Literacy we read the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We made porridge
 of our own and went for a walk whilst it cooled down. When we returned, our
 porridge had been eaten and we found a note from Goldilocks the language and
 vocabulary used by the children has been amazing!
- We searched the school for clues and made WANTED posters with our fabulous writing skills.
- In maths we have been learning about Mass and Capacity. If you would like to extend this learning at home I have attached a couple of challenge sheets (optional).
- We took part in a Judo taster session and absolutely loved it!
- We have been running on our school track to help with our fundamental movement skills development.

- In maths we will be looking at the composition and representation of numbers 6 7 8 as well as one more and one less.
- In RE we will be reading the story of the Feeding of the Five thousand (John 6 1-14)
