We believe in every child's potential, and we establish, model and uphold high expectations of all pupils.

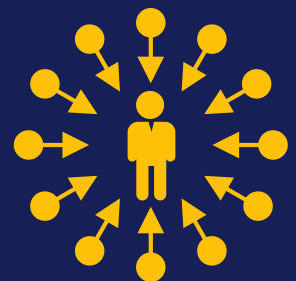


## Positive Behaviour for Learning
