


Mrs Clay's Y3 Friday Maths Task: 24th April

Measuring in mm and cm

We will be starting a new topic together on measuring. For your maths activity today, I would like you to use a ruler to measure the length of a collection of different things around your home. I would like you to measure the length of 10 items using millimetres (mm) and 10 different items using centimetres (cm). Have a go at measuring something in metres. How could you do this? Record the names of the items you measured and their lengths in your book.

Remember:

- Start measuring from 0, not from the very end of the ruler.



- Make sure you have the correct side of the ruler for whether you are measuring in mm or cm (and get an adult to check that you aren't using the inches side of a ruler!). If you don't have a ruler with millimetres on, an adult could help you, using the knowledge that $1\text{cm} = 10\text{mm}$.
