# RE- Holidays and Holydays

# Week 1

**Lesson 1** Explore our new topic. Pack a suitcase for a bear to go on holiday. (Alternatively draw ideas on template).

**Lesson 2** What is a holy day? Choose either Christmas, Easter or school's feast day for children to record what happens on that holy day. Make a 'happy holy day' card.

#### Week 2

**Lesson 1** Ascension Day, Jesus goes back to his father. Create a stained-glass window on a template in the shape of a dove or a flame. Talk about the choice of symbol and how it represents the Holy Spirit.

**Lesson 2** Pentecost: The Holy Day. Using craft materials make a face on a paper plate or a round piece of card to show how the disciples felt. Discuss what captions would be appropriate and display the faces with some of the captions e.g. 'The Holy Spirit bring us happiness.' 'The disciples were astonished.' etc.
