<u>Green for Growth:</u> Try to keep the punctuation you use consistent throughout, the same in each verse. Can you go back and check you did this? Edit and correct, if you need to.	Common Spelling Errors: I'm searching, but finding it very hard to spot any! Just one or two. Well done! Perhaps for home learning you could ask an adult to check for you, and suggest any spelling corrections you could make, to edit your work. Amazing effort, Year 3!
