- For this fortnight, you can focus on the changes in plants and animals (especially birds) as Spring is developing. On the resource sheet from me this week (which will be emailed to you), you will find details on how I'd like you to observe new plants, have a go at a Scientific plant diagram. I'll also be asking you to try a bit of bird spotting, and see if you can attract some new birds by making something for them. There are some video clips for you to watch to get you started, and then you can start exploring and noticing the changes that are happening all around you. We may usually take these changes for granted, but we have been given the time to stop and take notice, so really enjoy taking in the things that you may not have realised are happening every single day! **All resources emailed.**

Maths

Every day you will need to look at the daily maths video on **White Rose**. You must then complete the activities and ask someone at home to mark it. Your parents will have received an email with all daily tasks. There will be extra maths challenges for you to complete each day and you should attempt some of these. Tasks will consist of:

- Arithmetic tests for you to complete and mark yourself.
- Text book—work will be set daily, but you can complete in any order. Knowledge cards with facts to learn

GEOGRAPHY

We will be thinking about changes in terms of both physical and human geography. We will start by looking at how our landscape has changed over time by looking at weathering and erosion. We will then learn about the structure of the United Kingdom and how its shape and geography have changed over thousands of years. **I will email all the links and all the resources you will need.**

Lesson 3—In this lesson we will look at how boundaries have changed in both Britain and Europe and will think about some of the reasons why these changes take place. We will notice the difference between changes made by natural forces and changes made by people.

Lesson 4— In this lesson we will think about how countries may change shape in the future and how and why such changes might take place.
