Are one of the oldest-known animal species in the world.

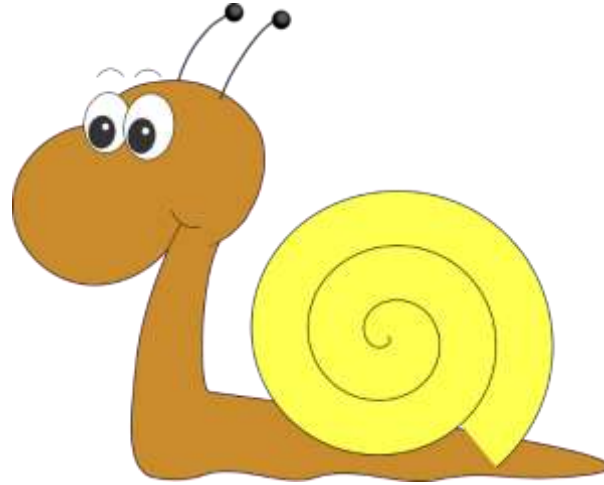
Are most active at night and on cloudy days.
