

# Bubblewrap Octopus

## You will need – (for each octopus)

1 red paper plate; blue coloured card; yellow paper; glue stick; PVA glue; sticky tape; white paper; pencil; black felt pen or wiggly eyes; red paint; scissors; paintbrush and bubblewrap.

## What you do

On the white paper draw 2 circles the same size, add pupils with a felt pen or use the large wiggly eyes. On yellow paper draw several circles in different sizes. Carefully cut out all the circles including the eyes (if needed). Using a glue stick attach the yellow circles at the top and the eyes at the bottom of the red plate. Draw a mouth with the felt pen. Make a gloopy mixture of half PVA glue and half red paint. Stir it with your paintbrush and paint the bubbly side of your bubble wrap. When the paint is dry, cut out 8 wiggly strips for tentacles – they don't all have to be the same length. Turn the legs over so that they are bubble side down. Stick each tentacle end onto the back of the plate with sticky tape. To finish, stick your octopus onto a piece of blue card.
