## Great Newspaper Report







Choose an interesting event to write about.

Have a short and snappy first paragraph that briefly explains what happened. Make this so that, even if the reader stopped reading after this, they will still know roughly what happened.



Keep your most important information near the top of the report. If the report ends up being too long, then the less important stuff can be cut out from the bottom of it.







Make sure you answer the 6 questions:
WHO? WHAT?
WHERE? WHY?
WHEN? HOW?

Keep your sentences short and punchy, so that it doesn't become boring.

CHECK your spelling and facts!





Having quotes from sources will make your report more credible and interesting. Include an interview if you wish!


