


Subordinate Clauses: Read through the slides below to remind you what subordinate clauses are:





The rain, that had been forecast, poured heavily.		


A subordinate clause is basically a part of a sentence that gives more information about the main clause, but which does not make sense on its own. You can remove the subordinate clause from a sentence and the main clause that is left will still make sense. If you take away the main clause, the subordinate clause does not make sense on its own. For example, on slide 3 above, the sentence: **the chicken sat on her eggs waiting for them to hatch** contains a main clause **(the chicken sat on her eggs)** which makes sense on its own, and a subordinate clause **(waiting for them to hatch)**, which does not make sense by itself.
