





### Primary sources

Primary sources are original documents from the time.

Some examples of primary sources are artefacts like writing of various kinds, clothing, coins, pottery, and statues.

### Secondary sources

Secondary sources provide second -hand information after the period of history.

<ul> <li>Primary sources are original documents from the time.</li> <li>Primary sources give first -hand information from people during that period of history.</li> <li>Primary sources are tricky to understand as they don't always give us clear information.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Secondary sources give second -hand information after the period of history.</li> <li>Secondary sources are written by individuals like researchers who are interested in that time.</li> <li>Secondary sources don't always have the truth.</li> </ul>

Saqqara is located around 18 miles south of Cairo.

It is designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site which means it is protected.

The biggest discovery has been a tomb believed to be around 4,500 years old.


The tomb is said to belong to Wahtye, a priest who served Pharaoh Neferirkare.








Egyptian archaeologists uncovered 3,000 artefacts and have been trying to piece together Wahtye's journey.




