- Talk about the different fairytale characters mentioned in the song. What sort of food would each of them like to eat at the party?
- Listen to the music and talk about what makes the verses sound different. Try characterising each verse with suitable instruments (e.g. tambourines and shakers played softly for verses 1 and 3; drums played to the beat of the music for verses 2 and 4; and cymbals crashing together to represent the big bad wolf at the end).
- Have fun making storybooks based on the song. Perhaps you could start with a large table full of delicious party food, followed by a different page for each character who arrives at the party, and a final picture of the big bad wolf scaring everyone away!
