

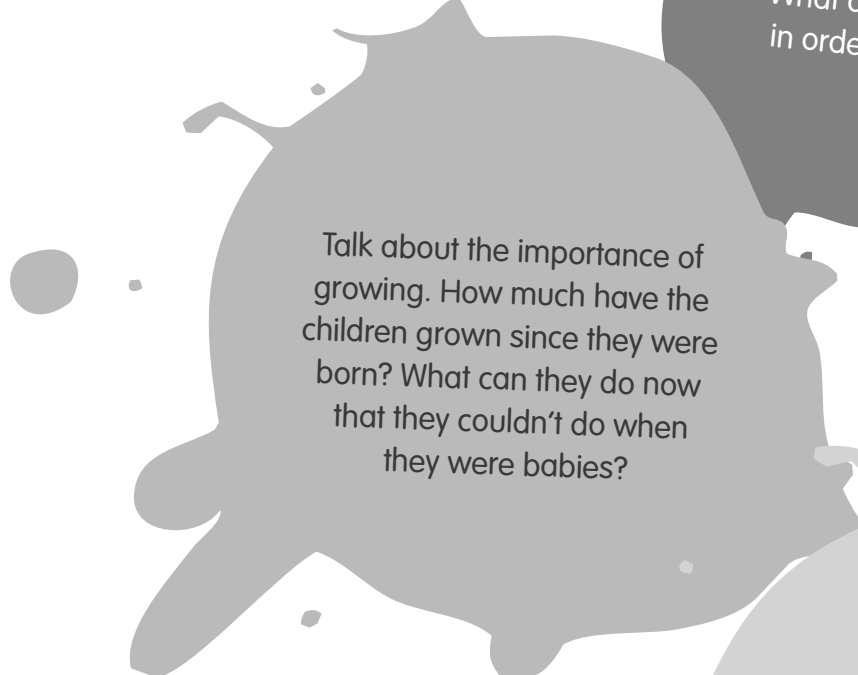

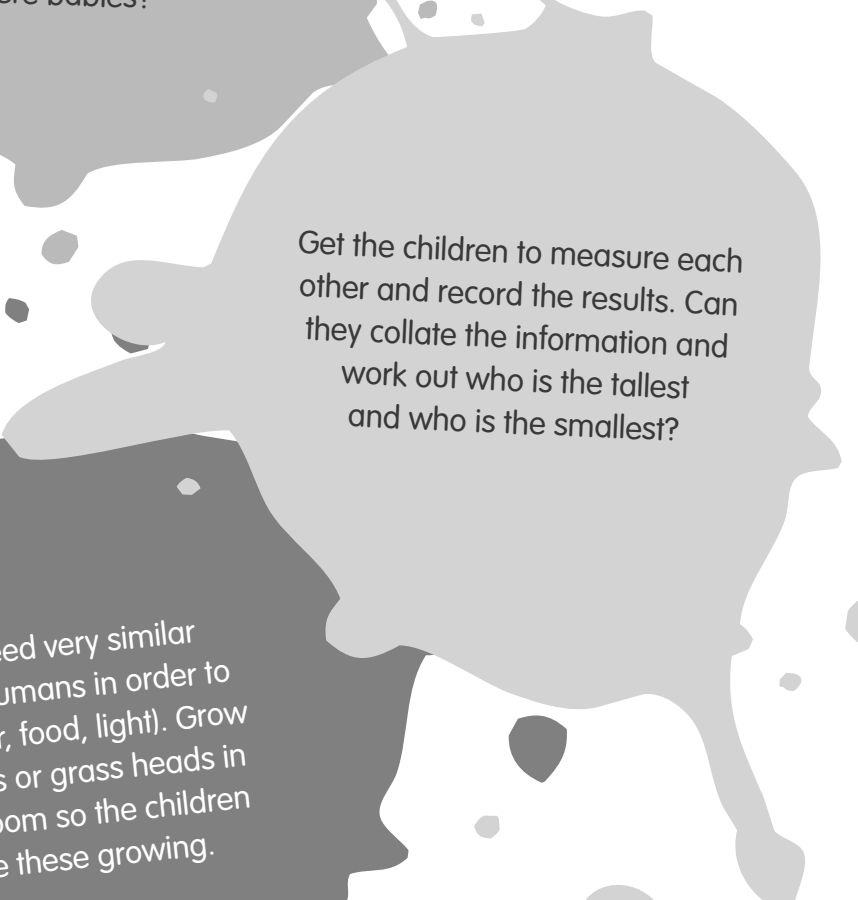
1. Every day I grow a little bit.
