General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)

On 25th May 2018, GDPR will replace the Data Protection Act 1998.

The GDPR requires public authorities and businesses to identify the lawful basis for storing data, audit information already held, and take a 'data protection by design and default' approach to personal data. It also introduces new individual rights to personal data, such as the right to removal or the right to rectification.

Compliance with the regulations will be an ongoing process, and the Trust have appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO) to advise and manage compliance with the regulation. The DPO's contact details are:
