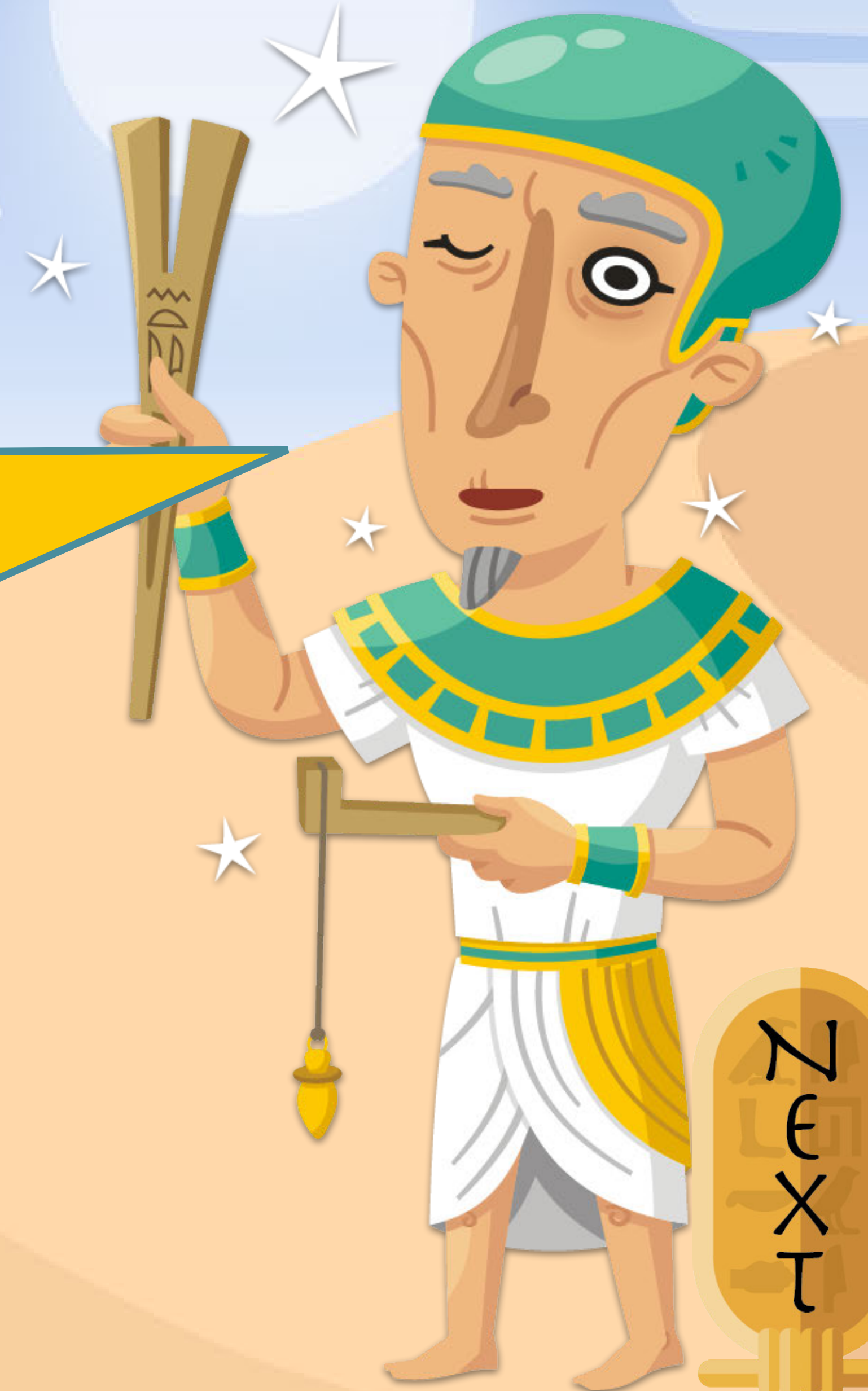

We need to make sure we include the important information such as:

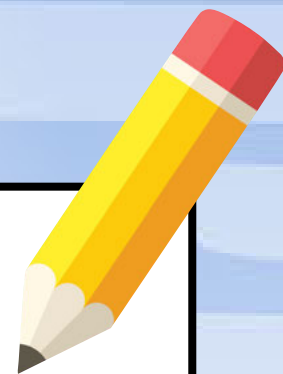
- Characters
