Most people agree that the source of the River Nile is in Kagera River in Burundi.

The mouth of the Nile runs into the Mediterranean Sea.

The main two tributaries of the River Nile are the White Nile and the Blue Nile.

The White Nile contributes 15% of the water in the Nile.

The Blue Nile contributes 85% of the water in the Nile.

The White Nile is longer than the Blue Nile.

Lake Victoria is the largest lake in Africa and is near the source of the Nile.

Some of the other lakes the Nile flows through are Lake Eduard, Lake Albert and Lake Nasser.

The Aswan Dam controls the flow of water in the Nile and water are discharged: stops it from flooding.

Around 300 million cubic metres of from the Nile every day.

The River Nile is the longest river in the world and is around 6695 km long.

The Nile flows through nine countries: Egypt, Uganda, Sudan, Kenya, Ethiopia, DR Congo, Tanzania, Rwanda and Burundi.
