
Terrible news!

Pharaoh Cleopatra has been found dead! This is horrible news for the Egyptian people!






What do you know already about Pharaoh **Cleopatra?**














She had relationships with the great Roman leaders Julius Caesar and Marc Antony. She had four children. Caesarion, the eldest and Julius Caesar's son, ruled Egypt with her from the age of three.

Cleopatra was the last Pharaoh of the Ancient Egyptian era. She was a popular and successful leader who was ruthless when trying to get what she wanted.




In the years before her death, Cleopatra and Marc Antony were involved in a war against Octavian, the leader of Rome.

Cleopatra wanted her son Caesarion to be the leader of Rome, not Octavian. There were many battles but in 31 BC, one year before her death, Cleopatra's forces lost to Octavian's armies.








Marc Antony, knowing that he would be killed by Octavian for betraying Rome, and believing Cleopatra to be dead, killed himself using his own sword in the year 30 BC.








Cleopatra was sure that Octavian would parade her around Rome to celebrate his victory. She refused to be humiliated and committed suicide in 30 BC. It is a popular belief that she used an asp snake to poison herself, as she was found with puncture wounds in her arm.







Before she died, Cleopatra made plans for Caesarion to carry on ruling Egypt.

This didn't work out. **Eighteen days after** Cleopatra died, **Octavian had Caesarion killed** because he was Caesar's son and was therefore a threat to his rule over Rome.



Egypt was then under Octavian's control as part of the Roman Empire.

Octavian changed his name to **Augustus and** became the first emperor of the **Roman Empire.**


