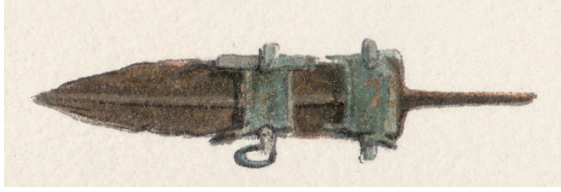

Weapons



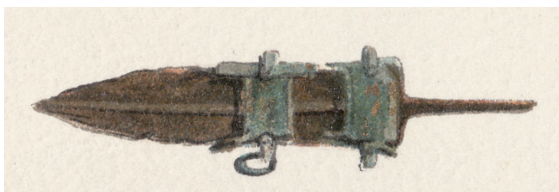
Used for protecting the body in battle. Made of wood, iron or bronze
