### Quality of Education

- **Continue to develop and implement a consistent spelling teaching & assessment programme across the school**
- Develop the opportunity to extend early learning goals into Year 1 to ensure basic skills are mastered
- Continue to develop teaching & learning around the arts in preparation for application for Artsmark Gold
- **Implement a new scheme of work for PSHE**
- **Further enhance problem solving, reasoning and language in maths through practical, active and investigative activities**
- **Implement use of picture books to enhance inference, deduction and analytical skills**
- **Fully embed a cohesive whole-school approach to planning and assessment of foundation subjects within the curriculum**
- Further develop computing skills within the curriculum
- Extend the work of the inclusion team to ensure all pupil premium children & those with SEND make at least good progress in identified areas

### Personal Development

- **Continue rigorous pursuit of enhancing mental health for all members of the school community including further opportunities for physical activity across the curriculum**
- Further enhance resilience of all children through the 4 B's approach
- Fully embed British Values across the curriculum in all year groups
- Further enrich the extra-curricular provision with new opportunities including gardening & cookery

- Further enhance transition procedures from EYFS to KS1
- Pursue ideas and initiatives for reducing staff workload

- Focus on encouraging free reading for pleasure

- Further extend working partnerships with parents and local businesses to enhance revenue streams
