Being a responsible citizen

Year 4 will learn about learn about rights and responsibilities as members of families, other groups and ultimately as citizens. They will learn about their responsibilities to protect their environment and the wider community.

Health and well being

Through our topic work, children will learn to recognise opportunities to make their own choices about food, what might influence their choices and the benefits of eating a balanced diet. They will also learn that bacteria and viruses can affect health and that following simple routines can reduce their spread.

Children will learn to reflect on and celebrate their achievements, identify their strengths, areas for improvement, set high aspirations and goals.

Road Safety

Children re-examine road safety issues focusing on keeping safe on the road.

Relationships

In year 4, children learn about how to maintain and develop a variety of healthy relationships as well as manage positive and negative emotions. They will also learn how to respond to risky or negative relationships and how to ask for help
